## Introduction & Mission

### About the Trust

Devbhoomi Divyangjan Gurukul is a registered public charitable trust (registration number: 313/2025), headquartered in Sudhowala, Vikasnagar, Dehradun (Uttarakhand). The main objective of our establishment is the all-round development of Divyangjan, especially visually impaired persons and disadvantaged sections of the society.

The founder and managing trustee of the institution, Shri Amit Singh Negi is a visually impaired teacher who is dedicated to empowering the Divyangjan by understanding their challenges at the grassroots level. The Trust is managed by an experienced Board consisting of dedicated members like Smt. Sita Mehra (Secretary) and Mr. Rohit Singh Rawat (Treasurer).

## Our Mission

- **Complete Self-Reliance:** Our primary goal is to make visually impaired siblings financially independent and empowered by making them proficient in modern computer education (I.C.T.), coding and digital skills.
- **Accessibility:** We are building a physical campus that is equipped with tactile pathways, ramps, and Braille-friendly facilities, so that students can experience a completely independent living.
- **Practical Skills and Rehabilitation:** Preparing students for every challenge by teaching not only bookish knowledge but also orientation, mobility training and skills of daily living.
- **Building an Inclusive Society:** To dispel the misconceptions about disability in the society and to create a sensitive environment through awareness (IEC activities).
- **Academic and Professional Excellence:** To prepare students for national and international competitive examinations and to provide a global platform to the skills of art and culture hidden within them.
- **Preservation of Art and Culture:** To hone the skills of Divyang artists and rural artisans and to take their products to national and international markets.
- **Mental and Spiritual Wellbeing:** Mentally strengthening and de-stressing students through yoga, meditation, and moral values (such as recitation of Bhagavad Gita).

## Key Achievements

Devbhoomi Divyangjan Gurukul has established significant milestones towards the empowerment of visually impaired in a short tenure. Our success is reflected not just in the statistics, but in the confidence of the students who are now joining the mainstream of society.

- **Mental and Cultural Upliftment:** The regularly organized online workshops and cultural programs have brought out the hidden talents within Divyangjan and have given their morale an unprecedented boost.
- **Academic Guidance:** We are continuously guiding students not only for skills but also for higher education and competitive exams, opening the doors of government jobs for them.
- **Social Impact:** Our biggest achievement is to reach out to the most disadvantaged and marginalized persons of the society and connect them with the mainstream of rehabilitation and education.
- **Inclusive Initiatives:** We have succeeded in breaking the stereotypes towards disability in the society and developing a sensitive and positive attitude.

## Why the need for an offline center? (The Need for an Offline Center)

Although technological advancements have made online education possible, its outcomes and effects for visually impaired persons have been extremely limited. A physical 'offline centre' is not just a building, but an indispensable cornerstone for their empowerment and self-reliance. The following are its main requirements:

### Limitations of Online Learning

- **Lack of Hands-on Training:** Computer software (NVDA/JAWS) and smartphone accessibility are extremely difficult to learn by listening only.
- **Hands-on Experience:** It requires the trainer's personal presence and hands-on experience.
- **Personalized Guidance:** Each student's learning pace is different, which can be quickly identified and resolved by teachers in the offline center.
- **Technical Barriers:** Internet instability and power problems in rural areas create constant disruption in online education ◦

### A Safe & Accessible Environment

- **Peer Learning:** When students with disabilities live together, they learn from each other's experiences, leading to an unprecedented boost in their confidence.◦
- **Orientation and Mobility:** Mobility training can be given effectively only in a physical premises
- **Safe Housing:** Many meritorious students are deprived of education simply because they do not have any accessible or safe place to live in the city.◦

- **Barrier-free infrastructure:** The centre will be equipped with facilities such as tactile pathways and accessible toilets, which will give students an independent living experience.
- **Collective access to resources:** Expensive assistive technologies such as Braille displays and screen readers can be made available collectively in an offline centre.
- **Social Inclusion:** Here students will not only learn skills but also become socially active through various cultural and sports activities.

## Key Programs to be Conducted

At Devbhoomi Divyangjan Gurukul, we are committed to providing not only education but also a complete life skills. The following important programs will be conducted regularly in our center:

- **State-of-the-art I.C.T. Training:** Visually impaired students will be given intensive training from basic to advanced computer coding, software development, and smartphone accessibility.
- **Competitive Exam Preparation Centre:** Special coaching will be provided for government jobs and bank exams, so that students can make their place in administrative and professional fields.
- **Orientation and Mobility Training:** Students will be given practical exercises to move freely with the White Cane and understand their surroundings safely.
- **English Language & Communication Skills:** Students will be given intensive training especially in English speaking, writing and communicating effectively to capitalize on the opportunities on a global scale.
- **Chess & Mental Game Training:** Professional chess training will be provided to visually impaired students to enhance their concentration, strategic thinking and mental acuity.
- **Soft Skills and Personality Development:** Special workshops on Confidence Building, Effective Communication Skills and Language Knowledge (Hindi & English) will be conducted.
- **Vocational and Skill Development:** Students will be trained in music, handicrafts and other small scale industries according to their interest and will be prepared for self-employment.

## Key Facilities of the Proposed Centre

The structure of Devbhoomi Divyangjan Gurukul has been meticulously designed so that it caters to every need of visually impaired children and provides them with a safe and enriching environment. The Centre will be equipped with the following state-of-the-art facilities:

### Modern Education & Tech

- **Smart Computer Lab:** This lab will be equipped with specialized screen reading software (NVDA/JAWS) and modern technology, where students will be able to learn coding, designing and digital skills.
- **Braille Library:** A vast collection of digital and physical Braille books, which will open the doors to a world of knowledge for students.
- **Sensory Museum:** A unique learning experience through touch-based exhibitions, which will give new wings to the curiosity and imagination of students.

### Residential & Daily Life

- **Clean and Safe Hostels:** Comfortable rooms with modern amenities, where students will get a safe and secure environment like home.
- **Nutritious Mess:** A spacious and hygienic mess, where balanced and nutritious food will be ensured for the overall development of the students.

**Daily Life Skills Cell:** Training of practical social and household skills required to make students independent and self-reliant.

### Health, Spirit & Fun

- **Medical and Rehabilitation:** Regular check-ups by expert physiotherapists and psychiatrists, as well as on-premises dispensary facility for first aid.
- **Yoga and Gym:** Dedicated area for physical fitness and mental health.
- **Peaceful Temple:** A sacred place for spiritual enlightenment and inner peace.
- **Recreation & Garden:** Recreation room equipped with audio-visual equipment and a beautiful garden to stay close to nature.

### Barrier-free infrastructure

- **Accessible Mobility:** Lifts with Braille marking and ramps for wheelchair users to reach all floors.
- **Security and connectivity:** 24-hour CCTV surveillance, security guards and high-speed Wi-Fi facility throughout the campus.
- **Special Vehicle Facility:** Specially equipped vehicle arrangement for the students to travel safely and comfortably.

## Proposed Budget Breakdown

- The estimated budget required for the construction and operation of this ambitious offline centre of Devbhoomi Divyangjan Gurukul has been divided into the following categories. We assure donors of complete transparency and audit reports:
- (a) Construction & Infrastructure CostRs.5000000
- The construction of a barrier-free (accessible) complex requires special engineering. This includes the following expenses:
- Building Construction: A two-storey building comprising classrooms, hostels, dining hall and temple.
- Accessibility Features: Installation of tactile pathways, ramps, and elevators with Braille script throughout the campus.
- Special Room: Construction of Daily Life Skills Room, Sparsh Museum and Medical Center.
- (b) Technical Equipment & Furniture
- Modern equipment is needed to meet the specific needs of visually impaired students:
- Smart Lab Equipment: Computers with Special Screen Reading Software (NVDA/JAWS), Braille Displays and Embossers.
- Braille Library: Collection of digital and physical Braille books and reading machines.
- Residential Furniture: Comfortable beds, cabinets, and specially designed tables and chairs for students to study.
- Security Equipment: CCTV cameras and fire extinguishers for 24-hour surveillance throughout the premises.

Student Wellbeing: Nutritious food, medical facility and fuel and maintenance of special vehicles for students.

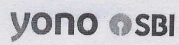
